RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1 Entry forms must reach the Flower Show Secretary **by Tuesday before the show**
Late entries only with permission of the Flower Show Committee.
- 2 Entries to be staged on the Morning of the show between 8:30am and 10:40am.
- 3 No unauthorised person will be allowed in the Hall after 10:45am until after the judging.
- 4 Awards will be presented at 3pm on the show day.
- 5 Judges have absolute power to withhold Prizes when the competing entries do not, in their opinion, appear to merit them.
- 6 Judges shall not be competitors in any class in which they are appointed to judge, and they shall not be present at the staging of the exhibits.
- 7 All the exhibits to be grown by the exhibitors or property of the exhibitors for at least 3 months prior to the exhibition, except for Flower Arranging classes section E.
- 8 No Exhibitor shall have **more than one award** in each class. **All classes are open, fees 25p per class entry and Young Persons classes are free.** Young Persons may enter adult classes, but will be required **to pay the full adult fee. All signatures or names to be covered up on all exhibits.**
- 9 Exhibitors are to provide their own stands, dishes, baskets and other requisites.
- 10 The Flower Show Committee will issue Exhibitor cards on the morning of the show. The proper placing of the cards is the responsibility of the Exhibitor **and should be placed face down.**
- 11 Points awarded in all classes as follows First 3 points Second 2 points Third 1 point.
- 12 Young Persons Classes: Age including 16 years old, **(Age to be stated on exhibits and exhibitor card both sides)** is taken to be the **age on the day of the show.**
- 13 All special awards to be held for one year and holders will be responsible for the safe custody of trophies in their possession and returned in a cleaned state. **If you want you name engraved please return by 30 June if not no later than 31 July.**
- 14 **All exhibits must remain staged until 4pm.** All exhibits remaining at 4:15pm will be sold.
- 15 All protests or objections must be made to the Show Secretary before 3:30pm on the day of the show and accompanied by a deposit of £1.00, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 16 **The Show Secretary's decision is final in all matters**
- 17 No responsibility will be accepted for damage to exhibits in the show, nor will the Show Committee be responsible for the loss of any article, but all ordinary care will, of course, be taken of them.
